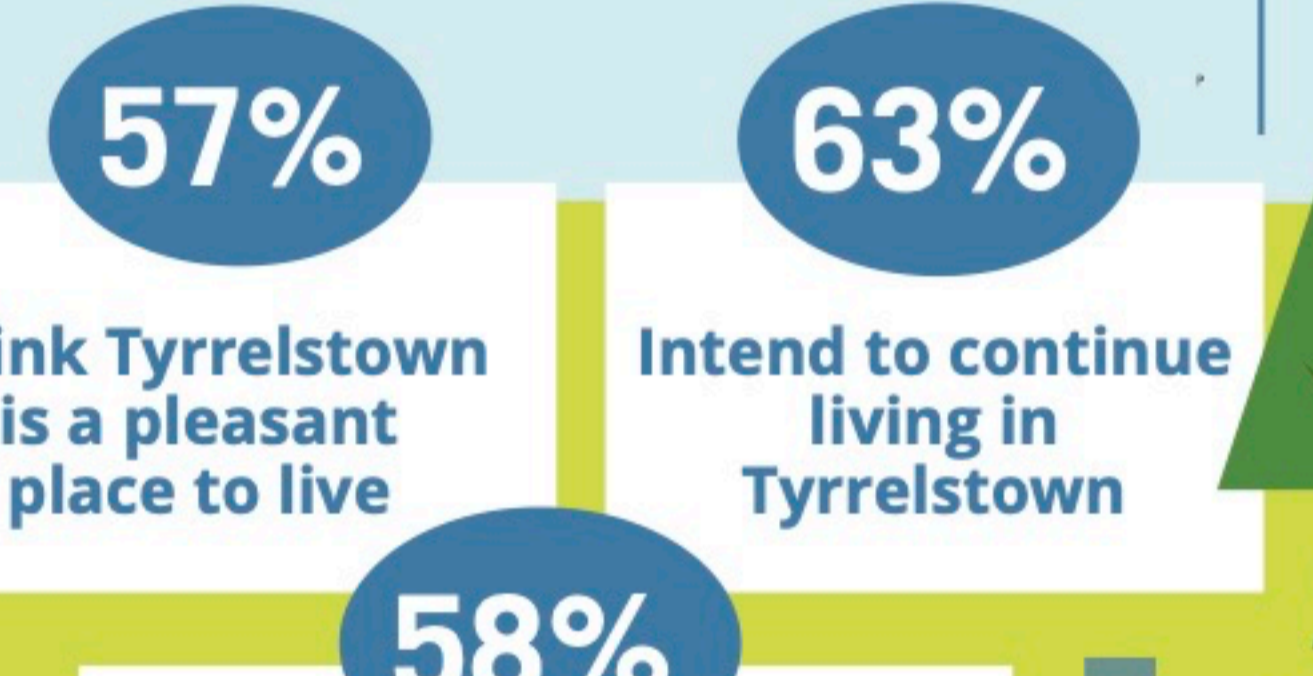


BUILDING A STRONGER COMMUNITY

A library can be used as a place to study for young people to meet.

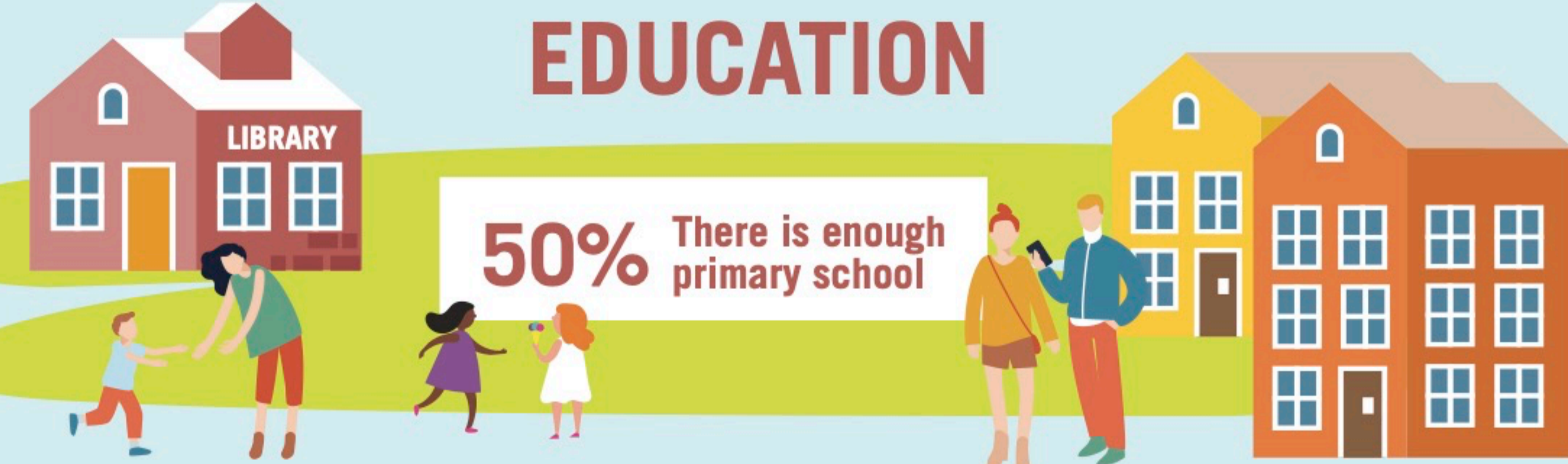
We are missing spaces where the community can meet and mix.

Community policing works really well and would benefit the whole area.

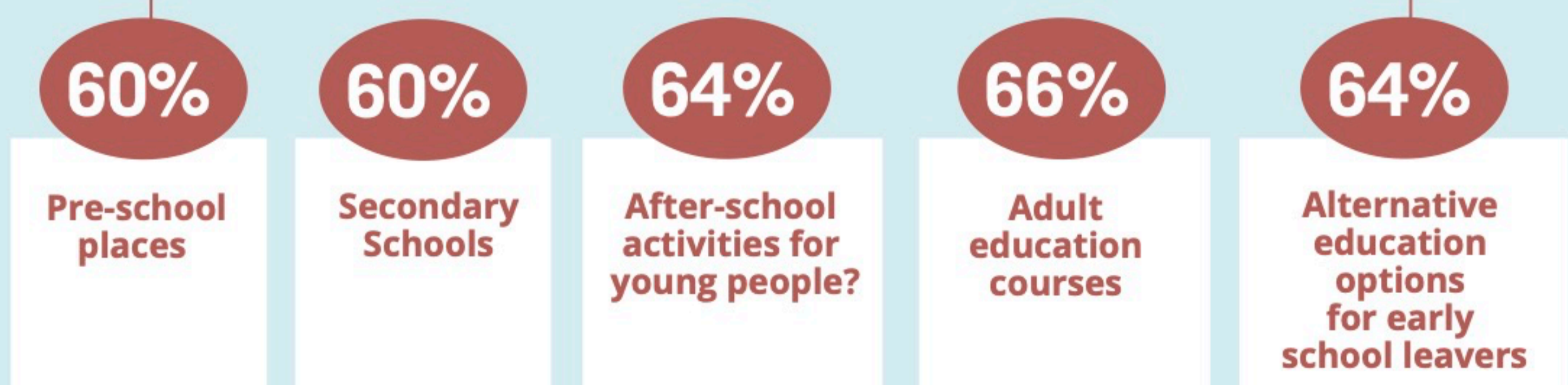
It is difficult for people to come together due to cultural barriers and a lack of communal spaces.
